Meeting Summaries:

September 21 -

Program: "Conceal and Carry," Presenter was Max Miller with the Lawrence Police Dept, introduced to us by Pat Riordan. Officer Miller is a fire-arms instructor for license applications. An applicant is required to participate in eight hours of classroom instruction (includes general safety, safety in the home, legal issues/descriptions, and both civil and criminal repercussions if you shoot a person), plus a short shooting practice lesson. Applications are available from county law enforcement offices and the Attorney General's website. There are fees assessed, photo ID required, background check will be performed, along with mental health and legal status checked before a license will be approved. Persons considering applying for a Conceal and Carry License are encouraged to recognize the immense responsibility that accompanies carrying a gun. Participate in a youth sponsorship program, such as Serteens, Collegiate Sertoma Club, Fantasy Sports Camp, Camp Sertoma, Boys & Girls Club, Junior Achievement or Scouting. **Yes, we support Big Brothers & Big Sisters through your Duck Race Fundraiser and members Matt Dowd and George Laliberte are Big Brothers. We also support Boys & Girls Club and Scouting through our sponsorship fund distributions. Sponsorship funds will be distributed in October. Other activities occur throughout the year.**
5. Participate in the Sertoman of the Year and Service to Mankind Award programs. **Pending. See committees below covering these activities. Deadline for submittal of this information is Dec. 1.**
6. Participate in a local speech and hearing project, such as hearing testing, scholarships, S.H.A.R.P., include brief description. **Yes, see committee below covering this program. Ongoing throughout the year.**
7. Have minimum average per member of combined service hours and dollars given of 250. **Pending. This will be calculated from the quarterly activities reports over the four quarters. 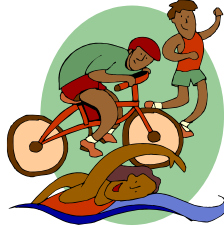
